

## **HEALING OF MAGIC**

### **Successful Completion Policy**

The mission of HEALING OF MAGIC is to empower therapists with research-based knowledge and new treatment tools to help motivate their clients to achieve function and measureable goals.

All HEALING OF MAGIC courses are considered “hands-on, interactive learning experiences.” Learning outcomes are evidenced through large and small group discussions and the ability to perform the activities demonstrated/taught during the course.

In order to support this mission, satisfactory completion of any course offered by our organization would require participants to:

1. Be in attendance for the entire time for any 3-hour workshop; be in attendance a minimum of 5 hours for any 6-hour workshop.
2. Actively participate in the learning activities and group discussions.
3. Be capable of demonstrating at least 75% of the activities taught in the workshop.
4. Be knowledgeable of the therapeutic value of each activity demonstrated.
5. Complete and submit a course evaluation/summary form.

Learners who are unable to remain for the entire course but demonstrate that learning has occurred can be awarded variable credit for the time they were in attendance. Variable credit will be awarded based on the number of hours in attendance (measured by actual clock hours and tracked by sign-in sheet and completion of the workshop evaluation form) and calculated as a percentage of the total clock hours.

*Example: If a registrant is in attendance for four hours of a six-hour course and has demonstrated that learning (based on participation in activities, group discussion, and completion of the evaluation form), then four contact hours would be awarded.*
